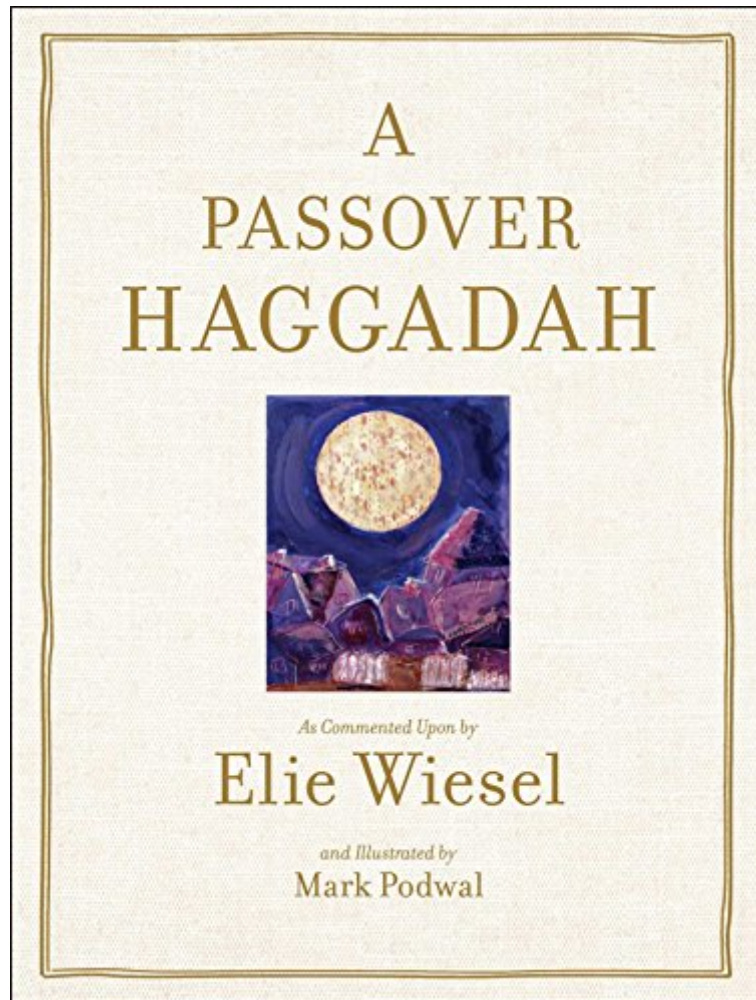

I like this Haggadah a lot. It is designed very well. I felt myself wanting more of Wiesel's stories to be intermixed (there were some, just not a ton). My only real complaint about this Haggadah is the lack of transliteration for those who aren't comfortable with reading Hebrew.
