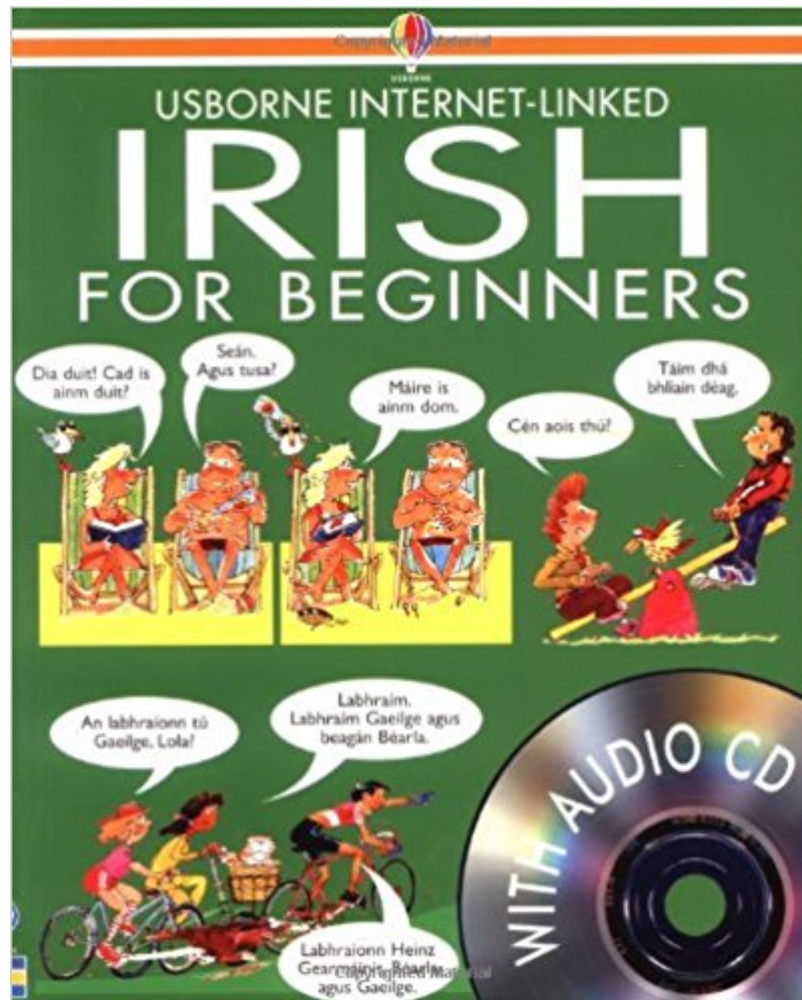

I have searched high and low for a WORKBOOK on the Irish language. I was under the impression that this was more of a workbook, and was disappointed when it arrived to see that it wasn't. This would have been OK had the CD been of any use. It went so fast that I was a few pages behind by the time I realized what was going on. Also, there are no pronunciation guides, and HELLO have you seen the Irish language?? It's made up of letters that make sounds OTHER than what that letter represents, and there are often several silent letters littered about. This is more of a second or third level Irish instruction book.
