

The most valuable part of the book for me is the colors/values table where skin colors are classified and three methods of creating values. After theoretic part, the book represents the detailed work process on one portrait using a photo as a reference.

Ron provides a detailed tutorial of every step of the process beginning with identifying the full range of values of the subject, and continuing through each layer of color pencil to obtain realistic portraits. A fantastic book no matter what your subject preference is!

This was a book on colored pencil portraits. It was easy to understand the techniques used. Especially the focus on facial coloring and gray values for shading. Very informational.

I liked the straightforward, nontechnical language from a person with experience you walking you through a portrait and even giving the time breakdown, tips and technique, and work in progress photos for color pencil drawing. The only downside is some glaring spelling or grammar errors (personnel for personal) that would make this book way more professional and polished if they were fixed. Read through it in one evening.
