

Chasing trout on mountain streams left an enduring imprint and drive to find new water... something that tortures Steve to this day. Of course, this was preordained since Steve's father (Hal Moore - coauthor of the NYT bestseller, "We Were Soldiers Once... and Young") was fishing in a local bass tournament on the morning Steve was born. His Dad claims to have had permission to go, but Steve's mother does not remember the actual facts matching that story. Winning a nice Shakespeare reel did nothing to mitigate the trouble he was in upon his return.

This book is a "must have" for anyone who wades the Upper Potomac for smallmouth bass. I have read several Potomac River books that were authored by a local guide and I must say that this book is right up at the top with those books. Steve has obviously put a lot of effort into this book and it shows. I hope he has more books planned that deal with fishing the upper Potomac- I would certainly purchase them and I have no reservations about recommending this book to anyone.

I highly recommend this series of books about Smallmouth Bass and Trout fishing the rivers in Va. After regularly reading the postings on Switchfisher.com, I ordered the Wade Fishing the Potomac book and was immediately glad I did. I have used the book extensively on several outings and have found the level of detail in this book to be amazing. The maps and photos provided have been invaluable once on the river and I take the book with me in a waterproof bag to reference on each trip. The GPS coordinates are also a great help and I have used them to print out google maps to take along as well. The water level section has saved several outings that would not have been productive due to low water conditions. I have pulled several nice bass off of a single log that was described in detail and appeared in one of the photographs in the book. I have just received the Wade Fishing the Rapidan Book for Christmas and will be ordering the Rappahannock River book this week. The Rapidan book is equally impressive and again provides details not found in any other books or magazines I have ever found. I can't wait for the weather to improve so that I can start hitting some of the spots highlighted in the new book. I am sure the Rappahannock River book will end up being my favorite since that is my favorite fishing destination. Finally a series of books focused on the details a fisherman needs to know with a level of detail that actually improve every

outing you have, and to avoid unproductive areas you may have been planning to fish. Most fisherman tend to be secretive about the hot spots they locate. The author has not only told us where the hot spots are, he has given enough details to put you on that amazing hole, next to the large rock on the left side of the river, 1.37 miles down stream from the bridge. It is like having Steve Moore as a friend who is taking you along while fishing his favorite spots. If you like to wade fish for trout and smallmouth bass, I would order all of these books. I hope to make it to the Flyfishing Festival in Waynesboro this year and thank the author in person for these terrific books.
