

The book is an excellent adaptation of the adult version. As a Christian educator, I have read this book to 3rd-8th graders. Each time the book has held their attention. Its analogy of our heart being like a house and how Jesus wants to transform each room in our house is done in a way children can understand. The book communicates some deep, complex Christian spiritual beliefs in an entertaining and simple manner for young readers.

Cute story, I teach at a private Christian school. Slightly different than the Kindle edition, but still great. I read this story to my class and give this little booklet to each child as a end of the year gift each year. The kids love it reading/learning about Jesus.

This is an amazing little book. I have the adults and children's on my phone. It truly explains asking Jesus into your heart and why it's important.

My 6 year old didn't really grasp the concept. I was sorry about this because this is the tract (in adult form) that got me saved 25 years ago. Also, I think this is more geared for a boy than a girl. Little girls don't relate to stories about sports the same way little boys do.

Having read the original, grown-up version of this book, I was curious about the kids' version. It is a truly beautiful book, the message concise, poignant, timeless, and captivating. The artwork is lovely, and though it probably won't hold the attention of kids under 6, anyone else can enjoy it. My seven year old son is fascinated by it, and we love to read it together. Like the original, it helps a believer transition from an abstract understanding of Jesus to something much more visual, personal, contemporary. I love it and have read it by myself many, many times.

This was exactly what I was looking for. It is a small paperback book for children that I can easily hand out. It has been loved by all I've given one to. Robert Munger wrote this beautiful story that connects to young and old. The illustrations are beautiful and colorful as well.
