

My head spun with the extravagant setups and procedures. If you know and understand the principals of what you are doing it's a great book. If you have done it before and want MORE out of what you are doing it's great as well. If you are a beginner and want a step by step guide on how to make wine? Ask a friend who makes it. That has been the only clear cut answer I have ever gotten. This is more like a science book vs. an instruction manual (for dummies).
