

Smith's extensive research answered so many of the questions I'd always wondered about regarding chickadee behavior. For example, do they mate for life? Yes, mostly they do. Do they form actively defended territories? Yes. And many more. One can only hope that an update describing more recent research will be forthcoming.

I discovered this book when Bernd Heinrich mentioned it in his excellent One Wild Bird At A Time, which has a chapter on chickadees. From the back: The book is the first comprehensive synthesis of

published information about this tiny, tough bird, with special attention given to such close relatives as the Carolina Chickadee and the European Willow Tit. Drawing on many of her own observations, Susan M Smith covers common study techniques diet and foraging, communication and displays, and the bird's annual cycle in terms of ecology and social behavior. She deals with aspects of chickadee physiology, explaining how they manage to survive harsh winter weather, and she discusses natural predators, population dynamics, and the most interesting areas for further research. "Studying chickadees can be addictive," she writes, "I've been hooked for years." This attractive book is accessible to any serious birder, and it also offers a wealth of supporting figures and tables useful to researchers. Susan M. Smith is a professor of Biological Sciences at Mount Holyoke College.
