In Acadia, writer-photographer Steve Perrin is true to the living spirit that stirred Thoreau in rural Massachusetts, Muir in the Sierras, Burroughs in the Hudson River Valley, Abbe in the southwestern desert, Berry in the hill farms of Kentucky, and other seekers everywhere in the landscape that sustain them, define them, and bring them joy.

All winter our hearts are on Mt. Desert Island, 750 I-95 miles north of us. All winter, with Steve Perrin's book, we take virtual hikes on "our" island.
