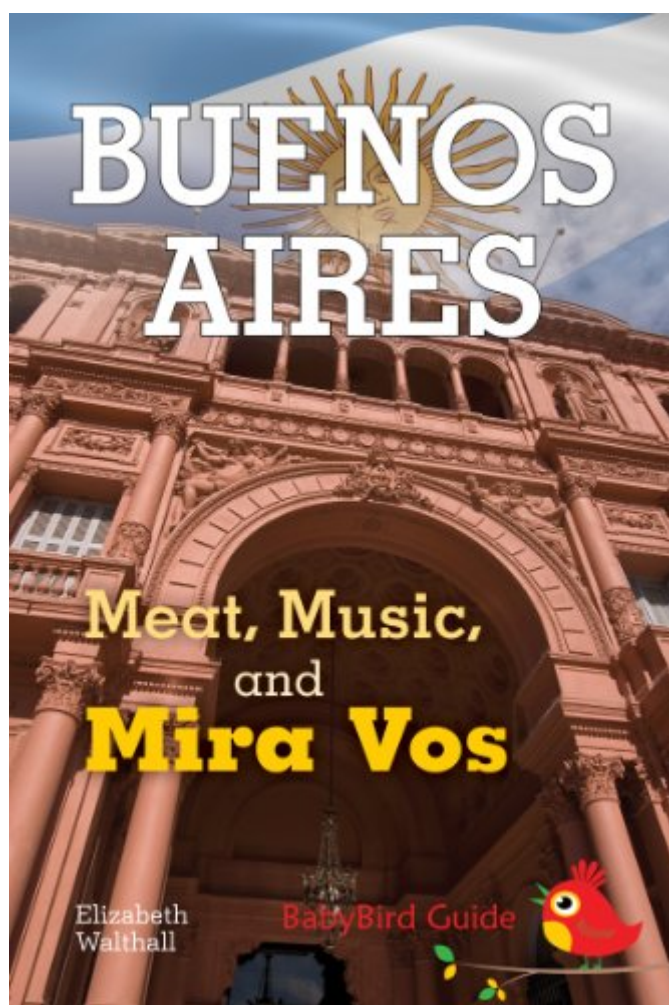


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The BabyBird Guide To Buenos Aires: Meat, Music, And Mira Vos (BabyBird Guides)

Are you ready to fall in love with Buenos Aires, Argentina? Avoid the heartbreak of trying to guess your way through the city. Instead, be completely smitten with this app-sized guide designed for your smart device. Get complete insight into everything about the city, including transportation, night life, and how to act like a local. In 30 minutes or less, become a *porteño* (a local), love-struck by The Paris of the South. Crack open your eBook with the touch of a finger and begin by reading the proud history of Buenos Aires. From there, learn how the local Argentine travels, eats, drinks, and speaks. Don't they speak Spanish with the same accent as the rest of Spanish speakers? Don't they love spicy food? Don't they ride horses to get around the city? No to all of those! (Protip from BabyBird: In Argentina they are very proud to speak Castellano, a dialect of Castilian. They speak Spanish with a uniquely different accent from international standard Spanish.) Get the basic 101 on everything you need to know for traveling to, and through, Buenos Aires. Easily reference the top ten tourist attractions, such as the colorful street of La Boca, El Caminito. But also, explore the off-the-radar local trends. (Protip from BabyBird: visit a trendy *Puerta Cerrada*: a closed door restaurant. Enjoy a set menu of whatever the chef feels like cooking that night in the chef's home.) Learn what you must do in Argentina, like enjoy a tango dance (called a *milonga*). Be sure to read what NEVER to do, like refuse an offer of *Mate* (mah-tay), the national drink. Fall in love with the city that enjoys Southern hemisphere seasons, yet maintains a northern hemisphere influence. (BabyBird says: in December, a flurry red-suited Santa still comes to town, despite the summer heat!) The edition is full of fun YouTube links to famous Tango songs, travel resources, and important tips. The BabyBird Guide to Buenos Aires can serve as a launch pad for further research, a handy e-reference while on the go, or a complete resource for a fly-by-the-seat-of-your-pants adventure.
