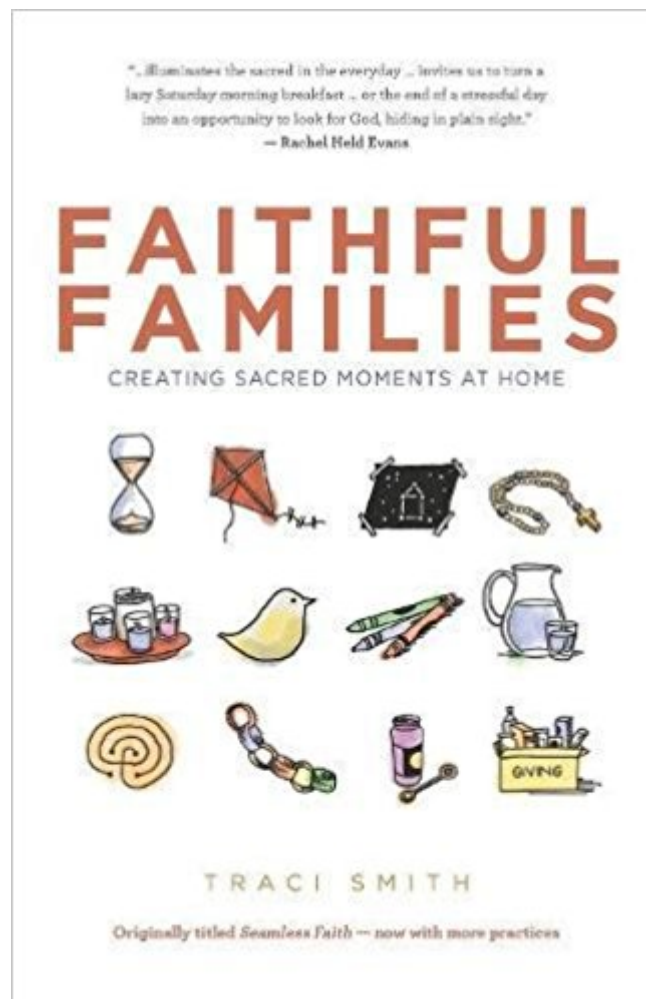

Traci Smith has spent more than thirteen years helping families find meaningful connections in living their faith together. She is the author of two books with Chalice Press, *Faithful Families* (formerly *Seamless Faith*) and *Fellowship of Prayer* (2015), and a contributor to *Out of the Deep: Pastoring in Creative Space*. Traci has a Master of Divinity degree from Princeton Theological Seminary and is pastor of Northwood Presbyterian Church in San Antonio, Texas, where she lives with her husband and children.

The practices in this book are simple and beautiful. Each one of them is clearly laid out so that families of any composition will feel empowered to share their faith with their children. Not all suggestions will be appropriate for every age and season of life, but each one describes when a child or family might benefit from it so that parents can make a determination about what works for their family. There are rituals for dealing with current events, for building compassion and generosity, and for comforting and celebrating during life's changes. I particularly like the rituals for building spirituality into everyday moments. I am surprised every time I look through this book at how helpful the practices are. Not just for kids, but they are meaningful for adults, too. This book is written by a Christian pastor, but parents of any faith, or no faith at all, will find themselves turning to the practices in this book to strengthen their family and guide their children in spirituality. Every parent should have a copy of this book - and my mom gives it to every person she knows who has a baby.

Traci Smith has done it again; helping families create meaningful spiritual moments in their busy lives! Her book is filled with quick, simple faith practices that any family can experience in their

Traci Smith's newly updated book Faithful Families is a wonderful resource for families wanting to invest in the quality time they spend together. A very practical how-to book on spiritual growth that can be used throughout the year. This is an easy to use book that presents ideas in a straight forward method. Early in the book, Traci encourages families to create a sacred space. She gives four key ideas. Focus on Comfort, avoid Clutter, engage all the Senses and make it Inclusive of all family members. Excellent ideas. This section alone is worth reading and adapting in a home. The book then looks at everyday traditions, like bedtime and meal time. From there it shares ideas for Holy Days during the year. The section on Easter Sunrise Breakfast is delightful and could create a new family tradition. Solid ideas that are easy to implement. Two full chapters look at spiritual practices with rich ideas. One of those is on hospitality. This section has ideas that include having an honored guest at your house. At the end of the book is a helpful section for grandparents and another section for ministers and ministry leaders. Both sections have good advice. I will be sharing this with the many grandparents in my church. I am very excited to share this

rich resource with the families in my church.

In my work as an Episcopal priest, I needed a resource for teaching young families in our congregation how they could practice their faith at home. I bought the Rev. Traci Smith's original book, which I have used in presentations and in my Sunday School class to great reviews. We have also used it at home with our little one, praying nightly with his picture prayer book, one of my favorite practices she offers. The best thing I think this book offers is flexibility; each practice has multiple suggestions for how it can be used, so if one of the practices doesn't work for your family/class, then it's easily adaptable. I can't wait to get this new edition! I highly recommend it for anyone with children or who works with children. You won't be disappointed!
