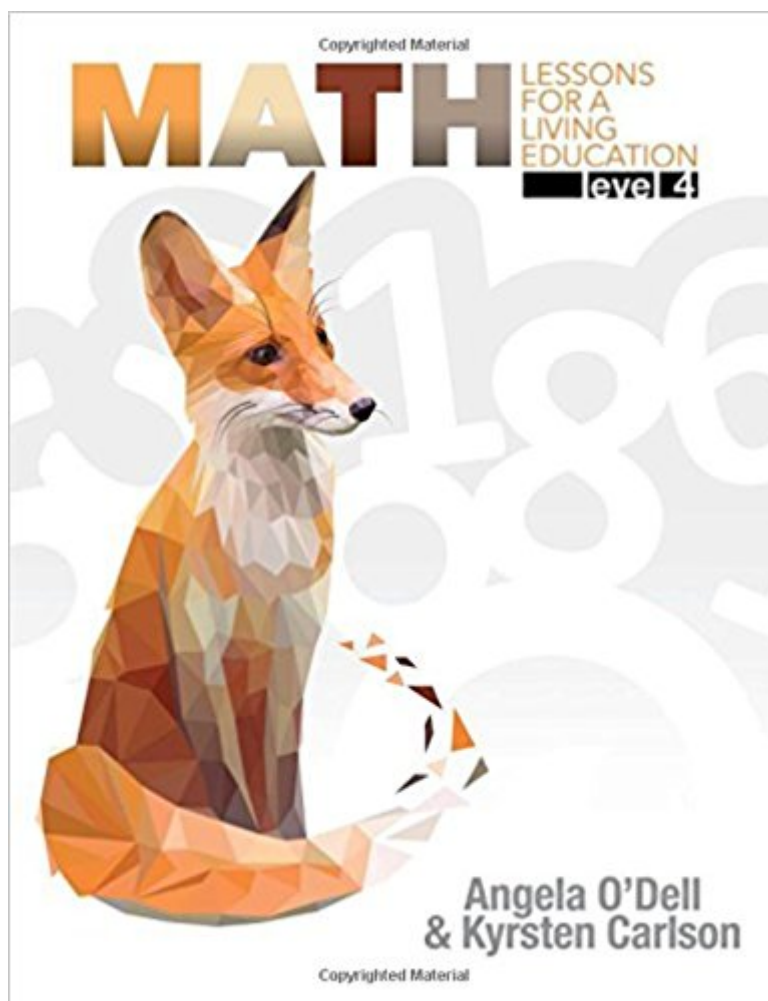

As a homeschooling mom and author, Angela O'Neil Dell embraces many aspects of the Charlotte Mason method, yet knows that modern children need an education that fits the needs of this generation. This is our second year in this series of living math workbooks. My son enjoys the stories, and the pages are colorful and engaging. It is great that this program teaches how to use the math in real life situations.

So far we like this Math curriculum (level 4). The only thing I'm not crazy about is there are not always clear instructions for new concepts (or perhaps concepts introduced before but that we haven't done since we are new to this curriculum). Example is Roman Numerals. There wasn't an explanation for what they are or when they are used today. How the numbers work wasn't explained either (like how the number four is written IV instead of IIII).

Not quite what I expected for a "living Math" and some of the content moves quickly especially multiplication. We stopped for a bit, reviewed flash cards and worked through Times Tales before resuming. HOWEVER, I do love that there is no "busy work" or "drill and kill." Overall I really love this curriculum and plan to switch my other daughter to it. It's inexpensive but GOOD.

I'm so excited about this math book! After using a "Drill and kill" curriculum, my son was burnt out on math, and our lessons would often end in tears. I love how MLFALE has short, manageable lessons. My son will learn what he needs to without ending his lesson in frustration every day! I'm looking forward to using Book 2 for my 2nd grader, as well!

My son likes the story but, it doesn't relate to the lesson and there is no instructions for the lessons. The math isn't above my teaching ability but u was shocked. Much more of a bridge workbook than a complete curriculum.
