

While Mr. Buffini identifies these as the seven traits of successful immigrants, they can be used by anyone seeking to achieve their goals. This is really a 7 step process for goal achievement. Unfortunately, as he points

out most people are not “hungry enough” to do what it takes. Mr. Buffini then gives a 21 point challenge that the reader can follow to realize their goals. Mr. Buffini came to America when he was only 19 years old and had a grand total of \$92 dollars. Shortly after arriving, he was in a motorcycle accident and confined to the hospital for a few months and racked up thousands of dollars of debt. But through determination and hard work, he achieved the American dream. His success has been extraordinary. If you want an example of what is possible, this is it. The book is well written in a very conversational style, which makes it easy to read. The chapters are short, the points/lessons are straightforward. At the end of each chapter is a personal story that illuminates the lesson of the chapter. The formula for success is not complex or even difficult to understand. What is necessary is the mindset for success. You will not discover any “success secrets”. As Mr. Buffini points out early in the book, “It just takes a committed mind-set and consistent follow-through.” So, if you want a straight-forward blueprint from a guide who has achieved fantastic success, this is it.
