

Let's make this clear. This book is an excellent read for someone following the Sufi path. But it

contains so much depth that an ordinary person will find it difficult to comprehend. The author is a renowned Sufi saint that shares his experience through parables. Each time you read the same chapter, you get a new meaning. This is not a book to be read only once or to be read at one go. You have to meditate on the meaning of each chapter to be able to understand.

As ampangbear said, this is not a book for beginners. It is, in fact, quite intense. When I read it, I had to stop and rest after a few pages! It is clear that Sheikh ibn Arabi saw and understood what we do not. His explanations challenge the very limits of our beings. Yet, in the end, we are left with the removal of another Veil that separated us from Allah.
