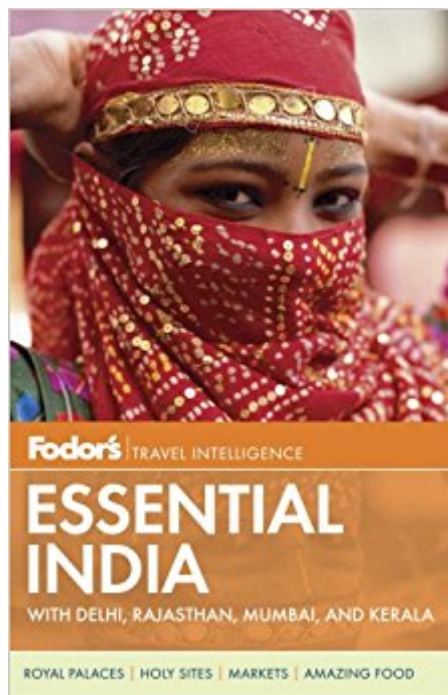

A more detailed map with a landmark or even better a small picture of the sight described would have helped us a lot to find the sights easier.
