

I bought this for my young daughter and loved the graphic on the cover expecting to have the same type of graphics. This book was put together SO poorly!! The images are too graphic for any child!! The only story in our book was of Adam and Eve and Joseph that's it... Not much of a book at all!! Nor is it for "just girls" ...terrible publishing.....terrible graphics....terrible "book"..... I bought it for Christmas and I'm just going to throw it away, that's how bad it is, not even going to take my time to send it back!

I liked this book! The font and background are very easy to read. The stories are simplified so that young children can understand them. The only problems that I found was that it was too short, and the pictures were a little inappropriate! Some of the pictures were nice, while others were an odd clip-art placement. Strange. I was also wondering how it's supposed to be bible stories "for girls". The stories were for children, yes, but there was no indication of the stories being specifically geared toward girls. If it was a collection of ten stories, though, it would have been awesome! I personally read three books to my daughter every night, so I was a little disappointed to only find that this book has two. I will still read it to her though!

I ordered this to be read to my daughter. She is still a bit too young for it, so I may have jumped the gun on this one. The stories are not bad, they seem to be pretty well written. The pictures are not bad either, they are pretty nice just a bit mature. That being said I do think I ordered this a bit too soon for my little one.

This was a very quick interpretation of main stories from the bible. The dialogue it is written in, is easier for a child to read and understand what each story from the bible is about, without using all the confusing text from the bible itself. The pictures are cute, and childlike, and flow well with each story. It is very easy and fast to read for an adult, yet I would see some words that a child would struggle with, creating another learning experience for the child reading. This is a book I would allow my daughter to read, and would recommend for younger children as a way to make the bible easier for them to understand. TL/DR Bible for girls: great Bible stories for girls. This book is written in a way that is very much like how a storyteller would tell a story. This book has a lot of pictures. It only retells two bible stories. The first Bible story they write about is the Adam, and Eve creation story. The second story is about

Joseph. Ok but know it is not an accurate, or full account of either story. Adam and Eve: I think this book brings the story down to an even more basic level than necessary. Instead of saying God made man from dirt. This book says God made man from the stuff of the earth. Kids understand what dirt is, so I think it was un-necessary to refer to dirt as stuff of the earth. This book also contains tidbits of advice or personal opinion from the author. An example of this would be "always remember that your life is the breath of God." This author has the creation of animals as being after the creation of Adam, saying essentially that God created animals because Adam was lonely. I do not like this inaccuracy. All the animals and fish of the sea were created before God created Adam. The author describes in great detail what they think the garden of Eden would look like. I think if you approach this book knowing it is a retelling of stories that are loosely based off Bible stories it is ok, but I encourage you to compare this retelling with what you find in an actual Bible translation. I think that would be fun for kids and their parents to compare the stories. In this story they really deviate from the original Bible story when they talk about the temptation of Eve by the serpent. This retelling has Eve lying about what God said concerning the tree of the Knowledge of good and evil. If this were true the first sin would not be eating fruit from the tree, rather it would have been lying about it. I think this is an important fact that even in the story retelling should have been correct. It mentions that eating the fruit of the tree was the first sin, but stating before that, that Eve lied makes it confusing. That part of the story did not need to be included in my opinion. This book does a good job of discussing the consequences for having eaten the fruit that God specifically said not to. I think overall this is a fair re-telling of the Adam and Eve story. Joseph. This retelling seems to jump into the middle of the story. It starts out with Joseph being sent out to check on his brothers. The author makes a big deal about how younger brothers are good spies for parents and that is another reason not to like them. I think the author may have had some conflict with his younger brother in real life. When his older brothers see him at a distance they mention that they can recognize him by his coat, and that he is a dreamer. It would have been great if we were told before now a few helpful facts. An example would be that he was his father's favorite son so he was given an unique and special coat, and that he has had some strange dreams concerning things that would come to pass. The story goes on to say that his older brothers wanted to kill him and lie to their dad about how he died, but that his oldest brother did not want to kill his youngest brother so he suggested that they throw him into a pit. His secret goal was to rescue his brother. The authors remind us thru out this story that God sees all. And then just like that the story ends with his brothers selling him to a caravan of Ishmaleite traders. I wish this book did not end the story there. There is a happy ending if they were

to go on, but alas I am not the author of this book. I did receive the Kindle version of this book for free in exchange for my honest review. However at the time of my review it is free to everyone.

This is a great ebook to help kids (and adults) who are just beginning their Christian/catholic education to learn the basics of the bible. The stories give a great overview of the stories in the Bible. I was never raised catholic and became baptized in my mid 20's. I think this is helpful not only for my young children but also for myself as I do not know a lot of the stories myself.
