Ayden wants to be a sorcerer, but he only wants to do nice things. Impossible. So, he finds himself on a quest with a non-wolf, a non-bear, a non-monkey, and some ghosts. He finds that not all his relatives want him dead, and people aren't easily defined. Fun and lighthearted (though with mentions of torture and attack rabbits). It's a standard quest book, with lots of side conflicts and a climax that's more important (and different) than the MC was expecting. I liked Ayden, even when he was grumpy. I liked that he was polite and always considering how to help others, even accidentally. The magic wasn't defined, but it didn't detract too much from the book. My biggest qualm is that it all seemed a bit too easy and sometimes a bit too random. Once, Ayden is locked up, and he reveals that his dad had taught him how to pick locks. Out-of-the-blue, Ayden gets free of the most powerful sorceress by picking a lock.
