

In 1971 my mom passed on and for 5 years I cried every single day but after reading Dr. Moody's first book Life After Life in '76 my tears stopped flowing and I actually became happy knowing what happens at death and that I'll be with my mom again. Now in his book Glimpses of Eternity it just validates it even more so. Exciting that the shared death experience happens so often and gives one comfort in knowing our loved ones live on. In this book Dr. Moody gives the first hand accounts [like in his other books] of those who've shared death experiences with loved ones, friends or patients. If you've lost someone you dearly love or are about to or if you, yourself may be passing on soon I highly recommend this book. It will give you comfort and the knowledge to help you cope with the eventual prospect of death.

Talking about death used to be taboo. I remember my grandfather dying when I was a child and no one really told me what had happened. At least I did not know what death was. Looking at pictures of my grandfather in his casket did however make me feel scared. It wasn't until my twenties that I actually started understanding what death was. I still had no idea what a soul was until much later. Lately while facing thoughts of my own mortality I've been more interested in reading about near-death experiences. I got a movie on the subject and then learned about this book. I had no idea that some people were sharing a death experience. This book is filled with compelling stories of people who have shared the experience of death while not dying themselves. There are descriptions of people leaving their bodies and following the dead up tunnels into heavenly realms. There are also stories of deathbed visions and indications that when dying people speak to invisible people in the room they are actually communicating with deceased relatives and friends. In the Bible it says that we are not supposed to try to contact the deceased but the shared near death experience and the near-death experience never seems like a conscious decision. Also, this book indicates that experiences are the same all over the world. I have heard otherwise. So this book is really a collection of stories and lots of analysis. Raymond Moody explains why the experiences are not hallucinations or the result of a lack of oxygen. The people who have shared death experiences all seem to be quite alive and well. What they see is a radiant light, heavenly places and beings of light. This can sometimes also promote a transformation in the human psyche. People no longer are afraid of death once they've had the experience. What I did find odd however is that there are no negative experiences. When reading about near-death experiences I've always read there were

some negative ones. So why not negative ones in the shared near-death experience? They do say however that negative experiences are repressed and people don't want to talk about them. So if you are looking for just a positive book you might enjoy this. I just feel it may lull people into a false sense of security. I've heard of many negative experiences with death and I think those types of experiences were just not included in this book.
