

These books are a very useful resource. We off-road explore a lot and consider these a requirement. Even though they are older now - and you should get current maps and info before heading out on your own - the information in these books is extremely valuable.

Not the fault of the item, but one must be careful when selecting a resource like this as to the publishing date. This was published in 2002. Conditions and even the locations of the trails themselves change too quickly for this guide to be reliable. We had some bad experiences after

planning our adventures using this guide trusting the information to be accurate. Once a resource has proven unreliable its value is greatly diminished.

The whole series of Back Country Adventures is well written, very accurate and extremely valuable to any off-road adventurer. I wouldn't leave home without one.

I've used this book as a guide to Utah's back roads for five years and simply would not have gotten along without it. Enough said - buy it!

As said by another reviewer make sure you update the information in this guide. In 15 years you can expect to find some changes to the directions in some areas, like Nine Mile Canyon which is now paved much of the way. Otherwise this is a great resource and well done, I just wish it was updated. I am now reluctant to buy other states Back-country Adventures books which are old.

This book is outstanding. It has been well used. It gives very detailed information for trails in Arizona. Almost impossible to get lost. It includes GPS waypoints for all trails. Definitely recommend!
