I loved the info and realized in comparison, my old resume was crap. As far as the step by step info on how to get hired; well the industry has changed in the last five years (since the book was published), they simply don't want you calling. Everything is done via internet now, which makes much of the info in this book superfluous. However I am glad I bought it and am using as much of the advise as I can.

If you are serious about getting a cruise ship job you would be serious about buying this book

I'm the captain of a (very small) cruise-ship. We do expedition cruising around Australia, PNG, Indonesia and Antarctica. Working on a cruise ship involves long hours, hard work, typically berthed four to a cabin, so little privacy, and six to twelve month contracts, with no days off. The reality is most Americans wouldn't put up with it, and since there are up front costs for training and flights (Four days basic STCW training) the shipping companies tend to avoid hiring over here. Americans have much better career options ashore, so they prefer instead to hire Philipinos or Indonesians who consider the salary good, by the standards of wages in their home country, and will tolerate the living conditions onboard. If you've got a special skill - musician, licensed deck or engineer officer - then maybe. But if you're looking at an entry level job bussing tables, or housekeeping then forget it - it is not going to happen. Read the other reviews carefully. In spite of the local addresses, they give the impression they were not written by a native English speaker. Friends of the author pumping up the ratings? I particularly like the one from Lions in France - I wonder is it near Lyons? There are a few American companies, who because of the Jones Act must hire US citizens/residents. Pride of America, sailing around Hawaii, operated by NCL probably offers the most opportunities. I believe Disney Cruises also hire some Americans, for childcare/ sheep-dog duties. You don't need a book to tell you how to contact them - just a yellow pages. I wish you luck in your search. I will say though, that although I've spent my life at sea, and enjoyed most of it, the life is not for everyone.

Since this will be the 25th, 5-star review I gave it a serious thought and summarized the public opinion for the book, what makes it a masterpiece as well as its author The World's N1 Expert on Cruise Ship Employment. I was jumping for 5 minutes after the successful phone interview was over and after I told my mom we were both jumping for another 2 minutes!
