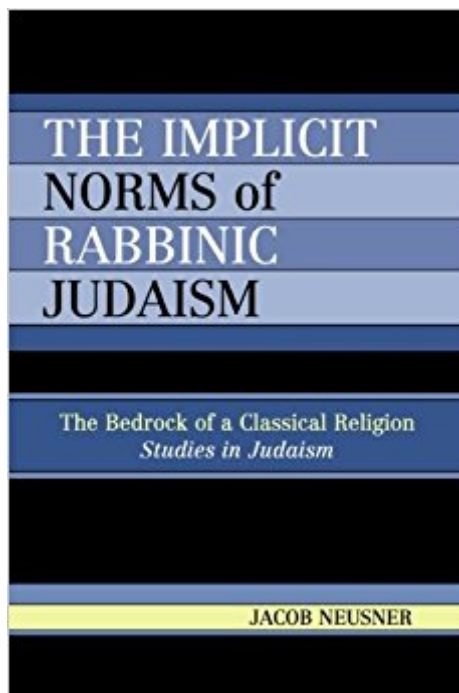




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The Implicit Norms Of Rabbinic Judaism: The Bedrock Of A Classical Religion (Studies In Judaism)
