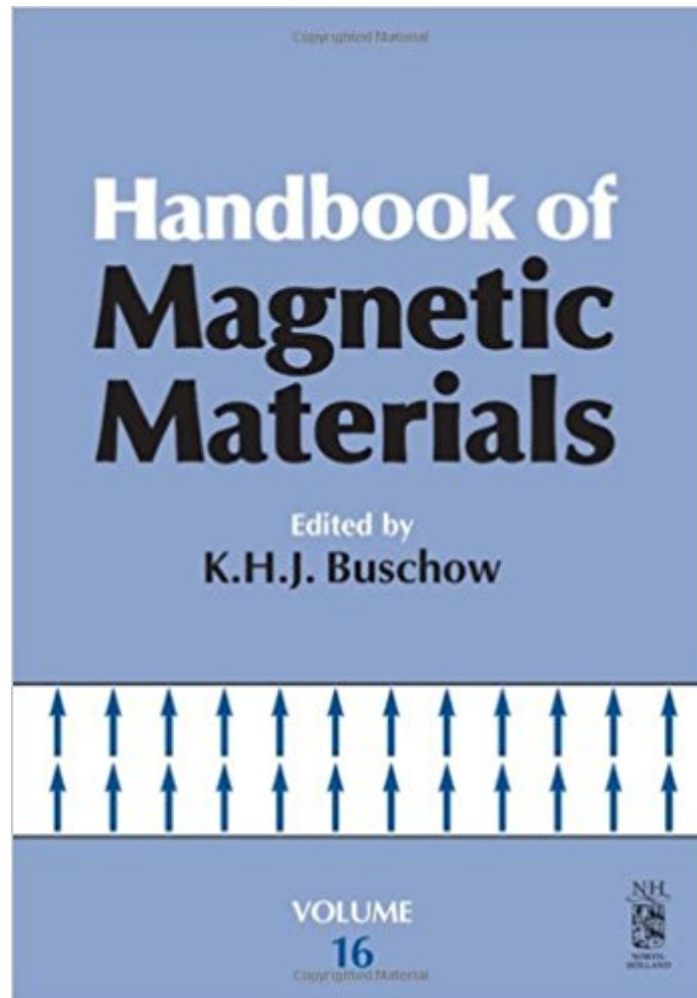




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Handbook Of Magnetic Materials, Volume 16 (Vol. 16)
