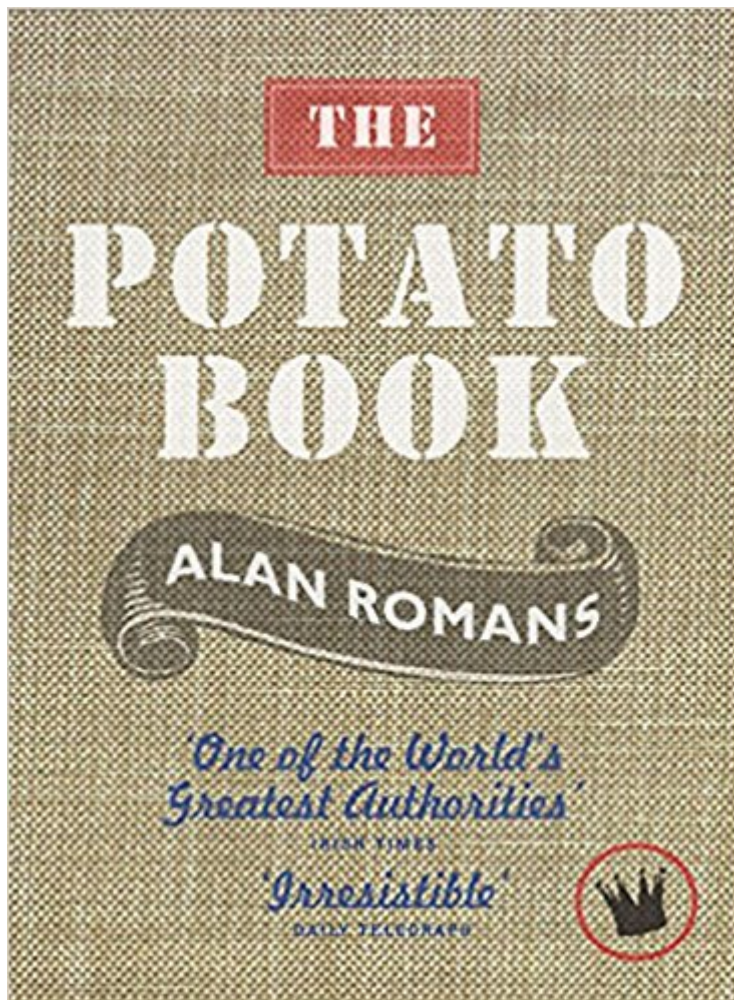

Alan Romans was formerly a biology teacher but is now a full-time potato enthusiast, a specialist potato roguer (selector of seed potatoes) and consultant to potato breeders. He lives in Fife in Scotland.

This is a great reference book for those who want to grow potatoes and aren't sure which varieties to grow. The Potato Book wasn't exactly what I thought I was buying. It doesn't spell out all the how-to's of growing potatoes in detail, but it's a great list, with pictures, of some of the best selections of potatoes to buy and grow. It was excellently written. As far as potato-growing instructions, I didn't find extensive (or even basic) instructions for new gardeners on how to grow potatoes. According to the book we are able to just toss the seed tuber into some sort of growing medium and it grows. Well, that's about all that's needed. I tried growing potatoes in a potato bag I found at and it worked, so I guess detailed instructions aren't really necessary, but this book is especially good for people who just want to know which varieties are available and the characteristics of each. Some probably aren't available here in the United States though, since it mainly applies to gardeners in the UK and EU. The pictures are beautiful, if a picture of a potato can be beautiful. :)
