

It captures the spirit of the Gospel of Mark. The only thing I didn't like was the recording of someone preaching that was added to the song about the parable of the sower. I think it was Card's grandfather, but the sound of the recording was distorted and the words difficult to understand. Rather than adding to the song, I found it a needless distraction.
